Skopje is the capital and largest city of Macedonia, located in the Skopje Basin along the Vardar River. The city covers an area of about 1,818 km² and has nearly 700,000 inhabitants. Skopje is a vibrant city that combines Ottoman, Byzantine, and modern architectural heritage.

ZRSRK RIBAR 2011 HOSTS OF THE COMPETITION

The Association for Sport Fishing Ribar 2011 was established with the aim of developing, promoting, and advancing sport fishing, as well as protecting and sustainably managing the fish stock.

The association actively participates in organizing national and international competitions, conducting ecological actions, restocking, and educational activities, in close cooperation with the Macedonian fishing federation.

As the host of this Cup, ZRSRK Ribar 2011 provides professional organization, fair competition, and safe conditions for all participants.



TRESKA RIVER

The Treska River is the second longest and one of the most significant mountain rivers in Macedonia. The section of the river in Skopje is characterized by consistently clear and cold water, regulated water levels, and a diverse riverbed structure composed of stone, and gravel with shallow and deeper parts.

The width of the river in the competition section varies from 10 to 25 meters, with a depth ranging from 0.3 m to 2.0 m, at an altitude of approximately 300 meters. The water temperature during the competition period ranges between 8 and 12°C, depending on weather conditions.

The river is rich in the native stream trout *Salmo Macedonicus*, making it exceptionally suitable for the SPIN discipline. For the competition, the river will be stocked with the same species of trout.





FISHING VENUE AND SECTORS

SECTOR A

Sector A is located in the upper part of the course, with moderate water speed and a depth of 0.5–2 meters.

SECTOR B

Sector B is located in the lower part of the course and comprises the left channel of the river (kayaking course), characterized by a fast flow with several cascades and a depth of 0.5–1.5 meters.

SECTOR C

Sector C is located in the lower part of the course and comprises the right channel of the river, with depths ranging from 0.5 to 1.5 meters and a mix of fast- and slow-flowing sections.

ELIGIBILITY AND RULES

National federations that are members of the Adriatic-Danube Association are eligible to participate. Each federation may enter three teams in accordance with the applicable regulations, while the host and the defending champion are entitled to field an additional team.

Each team consists of three competitors, one reserve, and a captain. Fishing is conducted exclusively using artificial lures with barbless hooks, in accordance with FIPS rules.
